

IMMIGRATION LAW – COST INFORMATION

We pride ourselves with the ability to deliver royal services at common rates. We aim to give frank and honest service, based on experience backed by modern technology whilst maintaining traditional values. Our charges are competitive and represent good value for money. We either charge a fixed fee or hourly rate depending on the nature of your case.

INITIAL Interview

We offer an initial diagnostic interview for a fixed fee of £100 plus VAT (if required). The meeting is for a maximum of 1 hour. At this meeting we will

- Ascertain what your legal problem is
- Provide you with possible solutions and advise on the best strategy
- Estimate the cost and time it will take to resolve your problem

Based on the information that we have given you can then decide, whether you wish to proceed on your own or instruct us to do further work for you. If you require a detailed letter of advice following the initial consultation there will be an additional charge of £200 plus vat.

Hourly Rates

We charge hourly rate for all complex or difficult cases including Appeals, Human Rights applications, Asylum applications, Fresh Claims for Asylum, Judicial Reviews, Bail and detained cases.

Our hourly rate range is £150.00-210.00 per hour plus VAT. The rate will depend on the person dealing with your case, complexity of the case and the urgency. We will discuss the rate with you at the initial appointment and provide you an estimate.

Our fees exclude VAT, Home Office application fees, disbursements and expenses.

Fixed Fees

Where your case is straightforward, we can offer fixed fees. Other than stated above we charge a range of fixed fees for all other immigration and citizenship applications.

The table below provides our current fixed fees for the various applications listed therein.

Please note that the fixed fee is due and payable once you instruct us and we commence work. This means that if you change your mind after you have instructed us, you will still pay us the fixed fee.

The fixed fee does not cover advice and attendance to home office interview. If you instruct us to advise and or accompany you to home office interview, additional fixed fee in the sum of £700 plus vat at the standard rate if you are subject to vat will be payable to us. This additional fee covers advice and accompanying you to the interview including traveling and waiting. If you require advice only, the additional fixed fee is £350 plus vat on the standard rate applicable.

Expenses

Depending on the nature and type of your application, there may be additional expenses that you will be required to pay. This includes Home Office fee for the application, immigration health surcharge, fee for translating any document written in foreign language, fee for interpreter if you require one for interview or to communicate with us. You may be able use your relative or friend to interpret for you when you meet with us. If you have interview with the home office, they may not allow you to use a friend or family member as interpreter. Please note that the home office and immigration health

surcharge are subject to change. What services are included in quote

The work will involve:

- advice and attending home office interview where required;
